Officers face discipline in shooting

BATON ROUGE, La. - The investiga-tion of a deadly police shooting that in-flamed racial tensions in Louisiann's capital city has ended without criminal charges against two white officers who confronted a black man outside a convenience store two summers ago.

But experts in police tractics think the bloodshed could have been avoided if the Baton Rouge officers had done more to defuse the encounter with Alton Sterling. They say poor factics and tech-niques may have aggravated the volatile confrontation, which lasted less than 90

seconds.

Federal authorities consulted two independent experts who concluded the Baton Rouge officers, Blane Salamoni and Howie Lake II, employed poor tac-tics. One of them said "tactical probtems" may have escalated the situation. thwever those use-of-force experts ul-thrately concluded that the officers used "reasonable" force against Sterling, according to a report released Tuesday by Louislann Attorney General Jeff Landry, Landry ruled out charges against the

two officers nearly it months after the U.S. Justice Department announced neither officer would be charged with federal crimes. Now that the criminal investigations are over, Baton Rouge's police chief plans to decide by Friday whether to discipline Salamoni or Lake for their actions in the early morning hours of July 5, 2016.

Baton thing Police Chief Murphy Paul said he will release other videos of the incident, including footage from the officers' body camera, and the store's surveillance camera, after he makes a disciplinary decision.

The officers told Sterling to put his bands on the bood of a car and struggled with him when he didn't comply, the re-port said. Salamoni drew his weapon and, using expletives, threatened to shoot him in the head if he didn't stop resisting, the report added.

Sharpton: Stephon Clark's death 'woke up the nation'

SACRAMENTO - Activist Al Sharpton, addressing the funeral for an un-armed black man killed by police, derided the White House on Thursday for dis-missing the killing as a "local matter" and said Stephon Clark's death would force the nation to confront police vio-

Sharpton give the culogy for Clark, 22, to the overflowing Bayside of South Sacramento Church as he held tightly to Stephon's distraught brother, Stevante, who frequently grabbed the micro-

phone.
The funeral came after 10 days of protests and community anger over the killing of Clark, who was was shot March 18 by two police officers responding to a report of someone breaking car

The officers said they thought Clark, who had just entered his grandpurents backyard, was holding a gun, but he was found with only a cellphone.

In his brief remarks, Sharpton noted that White House press secretary Sarah Huckabee Sanders, when asked Wednesday why President Donald Trump had not addressed the shooting.

. "This is not a local matter" Sharatan "This is not a local matter," Sharpton shouted, "They have been killing young black men all over the country, and we are here to say that we are going to stand with Stephon Clark and his family," Sharpton told mourners that Clark "wake up the nation."

said Clark's killing was especially pain

"No mother should have to go through this and lose their children this type of way," Thompson said. This is harrific, this is violence, and all mothers

Some mourners attending Wednesday's wake called for police to flace criminal charges or donned black shirts calling for justice.

The killing has sparked more than a week of newer and mostly nonviolent
