Activities allowed by this permit are as follows:

Installation of storm drainage, excavation and fill as shown on plans titled Oyster Harbor at Fiddler's Creek Phase 1 Construction Plans, sheets 1, 7 and 21 of 21, prepared by Grady Minor, signed and sealed by Mark Minor, Dated 2/26/2014.

STANDARD GENERAL CONDITIONS

- 1. The areas to be preserved and protected must be marked with "envirofence" and the perimeters of all disturbed areas must be protected from erosion by the installation of silt screen.
- 2. If any blasting is to be done, a blasting permit must be obtained from the Collier County Engineering and Environmental Services Department.
- 3. No dewatering is allowed unless a dewatering permit is obtained from the South Florida Water Management District.
- 4. Ingress and Egress to and from the site must be through permitted driveways properly constructed to NPDES standards.
- 5. Burning of cleared vegetation is prohibited unless proper permits are obtained from the local Fire Official and Florida Division of Forestry.
- 6. This Early Work Authorization is valid for a period of 60 days, after which all work must cease until proper final permit approval is obtained. (SEE EXPIRATION DATE ON FRONT OF PERMIT)
- 7. In the event that work ceases for any reason, all bonds must be maintained in force until permits are obtained or until restoration to initial condition is complete.
- 8. Only storm drains that are part of the main stormwater system connecting the lakes and retention areas together and to the outfall can be installed under this permit.

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9. If, for any reason, the underlying SDP or PPL is not approved, the property owner will be responsible for revegetation of the site in accordance with Section 4.06.04.A.1.a.vii.d of the Land Development Code.

Special Conditions
