CONDITIONS OF PERMIT

1. A copy of this permit must be on the blasting site during blasting activity.
2. During the active blasting segment, continuous seismic monitoring is required, with seismograph reports analyzed by a seismologist who shall sign and submit the reports monthly to the Engineering & ROW Inspections Section (attention: Jack McKenna).
3. Should complaints be received and it be determined that the number of pounds per hole or holes per shot are in excess, they shall be modified as approved by the Engineering & ROW Inspections Section.
4. Notify the Engineering & ROW Inspections Section at 239-252-2391 and the appropriate Sheriff Substation's Duty Officer at least twenty-four (24) hours prior to commencement of detonation segment throughout the approved permit period.
5. Development Review Section (Matthew McLean) shall be provided with copies of your renewed Annual State Blaster Permit and User License when received from the State of Florida, but not later than October 30, of current year.
6. Advise the Engineering & ROW Inspections Section (Daryl Hughes) as to location of your drilling rig within the blasting site.
7. Collier County Excavation Ordinance number 04-55, Section 2.E., Article IV, Section 22-111, 12, h., states that no overburden is to be removed prior to blasting from area planned for excavation unless otherwise approved by the County Manager or designee. Should the User / Blaster determine the overburden has been removed immediate notification to the Engineering Review Section is required.
8. Instituting traffic control measures as necessary.
9. You are hereby officially notified that the Engineering & ROW Inspections Section reserves the right to suspend or revoke this permit if a violation of Collier County's Blasting Ordinance should occur or if complaints are not addressed in a satisfactory manner as determined by the Engineering & ROW Inspections Section. Should this permit be suspended or revoked, appeal by the User / Blaster shall be in accordance with County Ordinance number 04-55, Section 2.D., Article 1, Section 55-15, Revocation and / or Suspension of permit, as amended.
10. Upon receipt of this permit and prior to commencement of blasting at the site, the User/Blaster agrees to comply with all conditions of this Permit. Any deviation from the requirements without approval shall cause this permit to become null and void.
11. Issuance of a development permit by a county does not in any way create any rights on the part of the applicant to obtain a permit from a state or federal agency and does not create any liability on the part of the county for issuance of the permit if the applicant fails to obtain requisite approvals or fulfill the obligations imposed by a state or federal agency or undertakes actions that result in a violation of state or federal law. This permit is conditioned on all other applicable state or federal permits being obtained before commencement of the development.
