This letter serves **as verification of the permit modification completed on February 2, 2017**. Please include this project identification number **FLR10PI91** on all future correspondence to the Department regarding this permit.

To terminate your coverage prior to this expiration date, you must file a *National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Stormwater Notice of Termination*, DEP Form 62-621.300(6) (NOT).

To renew your coverage beyond the expiration date, you must submit a new NOI and processing fee to the Department no later than two days before coverage expires.

Until your permit coverage is terminated, modified, or revoked, you are authorized to discharge stormwater from the site referenced in your NOI to surface waters in accordance with the terms and conditions of your permit. Key conditions include but are not limited to:

- implementation of your stormwater pollution prevention plan (SWPPP);
- conducting and documenting routine inspections or discharge monitoring; and
- retaining the records required by the permit (including your SWPPP) at the site or the alternate location specified in your NOI.
